First, check the online calendar to make sure the site is free when you want to use it, alternatively contact the office (details below), then just fill out the forms that apply to your group.

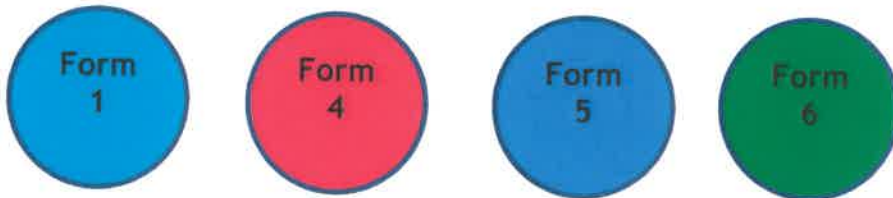

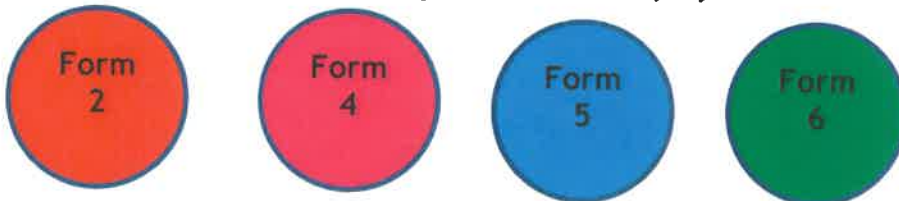

Form 1: Youth Group and Youth/Adult Leader booking information

Cheviot View is situated in the centre of the rural hamlet of Kirknewton. This is the perfect location for those wanting large accommodation that is ideal for club/youth groups and provides a central base to experience all the adventure that Northumberland has to offer. The Lodge and Campsite can be booked independently or together.

The Lodge: Sleeps 36 in 5 bedrooms: 3 dorms sleeping 10, 10 and 8 people, leaders' room sleeping 5 with ensuite, 1 wheelchair accessible room downstairs sleeping 3 with ensuite. Bathroom facilities include 2 rooms with 3 toilets and separate room with 4 shower cubicles upstairs, 1 additional toilet and shower downstairs. Fully fitted kitchen, lounge, activity room and cloaks. Adventure playground on site next to the Lodge is shared with the campsite.

Campsite: Fully equipped campsite, capacity of 20 pitches / 40 occupants, 4 showers and 4 toilets including 1 wet room, storeroom with sink, fridge freezer, kettle, microwave and cooking/ eating utensils and plates etc. for 40 people. Use of upstairs bothy for shelter. Bring your tent, clothes and food.

Booking Information:

Bookings are secured on receipt of booking form and deposit, (cheque payable to North Tyneside Guide Association) or if you would like to pay via online banking, contact the office for further details.

The Lodge: Youth Groups/Schools/ D of E: £9.00 per person per night,
Youth Leader/ Adult leader booking: £12.00 per person per night,

minimum charge of £100.00 per night; non-returnable deposit £60.00;
£15.00 per night fuel levy charged October to April. (Please note wood is not provided for the wood burning stove).

Campsite: £5.00 per person per night, minimum charge of £30.00 per night; non-returnable deposit £30.00.

Balance of Payments: This is due 1 month prior to your reserved date so we can organise keys etc. If payment is not made by this date we will assume the booking can be cancelled. Keys will only be issued on payment of the full balance.

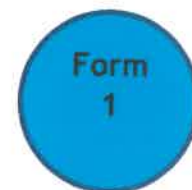
Arrivals and Departures: 3.00pm arrival, 2.00pm departure. (Times negotiable).

Campsite: Fully equipped campsite, capacity of 20 pitches / 40 occupants, 4 showers and 4 toilets including 1 wet room, storeroom with sink, fridge freezer, kettle, microwave and cooking/eating utensils and plates etc. for 40 people. Use of upstairs bothy for shelter. Bring your tent, clothes and food.

Booking Information: Bookings can be taken no more than 6 months in advance for weekends and school holidays. Bookings can be taken anytime for term time, week days. Receipt of your deposit (cheque payable to North Tyneside Guide Association), confirms your booking. If you would like to pay via online banking, contact the office for further details.

The Lodge: General public, inclusive of number of children: £15.00 per person per night, minimum charge of £150.00 per night; non-returnable deposit £60.00; £15.00 per night fuel levy charged October to April. (Please note wood is not provided for the wood burning stove).

Campsite: £5.00 per person per night, minimum charge of £30.00 per night; non-returnable deposit £30.00

Balance of Payments: This is due 1 month prior to your reserved date so we can organise keys etc. If payment is not made by this date we will assume the booking can be cancelled. Keys will only be issued on payment of the full balance.

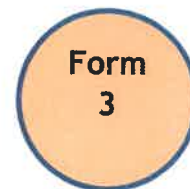

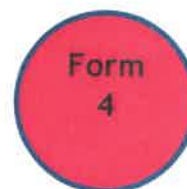

Form 5: Cheviot View Lodge and Campsite Rules



The residents of Kirknewton pride themselves on their small but lovely hamlet. Please help them to keep the hamlet beautiful and by our actions be a good P.R. representative for Girlguiding. Please conduct yourself with due regard to others at all times.

1. No arrivals or departures are to take place after 21:00 hours, except in cases of emergency or with prior agreement.
2. Please keep noise to a minimum throughout your stay. Quiet must be observed between the hours of 22:30 (absolute quiet after 23:00) until 07:00. When arriving or returning to the campsite at night please remember that other campers and residents of Kirknewton may be asleep and behave accordingly.
3. No stereos or amplified musical instruments are to be played on the site at any time. This rule may be relaxed for small stereos and acoustic instruments with prior agreement of Girlguiding North Tyneside between the hours of 10am - 8pm provided noise levels are kept to a minimum and are not intrusive upon other campers or the residents of Kirknewton.
4. Any generators used on site are to be of the appropriately silenced type and are not permitted for use after 20:00 (without prior agreement of Girlguiding North Tyneside) as they can spoil the peace and tranquillity of the evening for our neighbours.
5. The discharge of fireworks is strictly prohibited on the campsite and surrounding areas, unless within the appropriate season and with prior agreement of Girlguiding North Tyneside.
6. Vehicles are not allowed on the grassed areas. Vehicles must park in the car park.
7. Pets are not allowed at Cheviot View. Guide dogs are the only exception.
8. Please respect St. Gregory's churchyard and do not let groups go in there unsupervised.
9. We operate a no smoking policy at Cheviot View on all areas of the site including the car park.
10. Please note that outdoor cooking must be on raised altar fires or the fixed fire places, turfing is not allowed.
11. Please do not empty sanitary bins; contents are disposed of safely by a clinical waste firm.
12. Contract Terms - please note that these rules and conditions form the basis of our contract with you.

We have drawn up these guidelines for your benefit and that of others in the area, ensuring that your stay will be pleasurable and at the same time enabling us to continue our work in this lovely part of Northumberland.

NB: Girlguiding North Tyneside reserves the right to ask any group to vacate the Outdoor Centre and make good any damage caused. Anyone found to be in serious breach of the site rules may be asked to leave with immediate effect, without any refund and may be refused future admission to Cheviot View. We thank you for your co-operation.
